

Overview of MI Health Link



What is MI Health Link?

- A new program that joins Medicare and Medicaid benefits, rules and payments into **one** coordinated delivery system
- Three-way agreement between CMS, MDCH and procured Integrated Care Organizations (ICO)
- ICOs hold sub-contracts with Pre-Paid Inpatient Health Plans (PIHP) for behavioral health
- Operates in four regions in the state.

What makes this program different?

- Delivery system for Medicare and Medicaid covered services will work in unison rather than in silos.
- Simplified billing processes with the ICO as the single payer source.
- Each enrollee will have a care coordinator and an Integrated Care Team (ICT) to link them to services provided by the ICO and PIHP.
- Person-centered planning, rather than a physician driven approach, is used in creating an individualized care plan.

Better care by making it easier for dual eligible individuals to get all of their health care from a single Medicare-Medicaid Plan.

Better value through a care team and a care manager that works directly with the member and their doctors.

Better health through benefits that will help members stay healthy and live at home as long as possible.

- No co-payments or deductibles for in-network services, **including medications.**
- One health plan to manage all Medicare and Medicaid covered services.
- One card to access all services.

- Person-centered care with a focus on supports for community living, not just doctor-driven medicine.
- Access to a 24/7 Nurse Advice Line to answer questions.

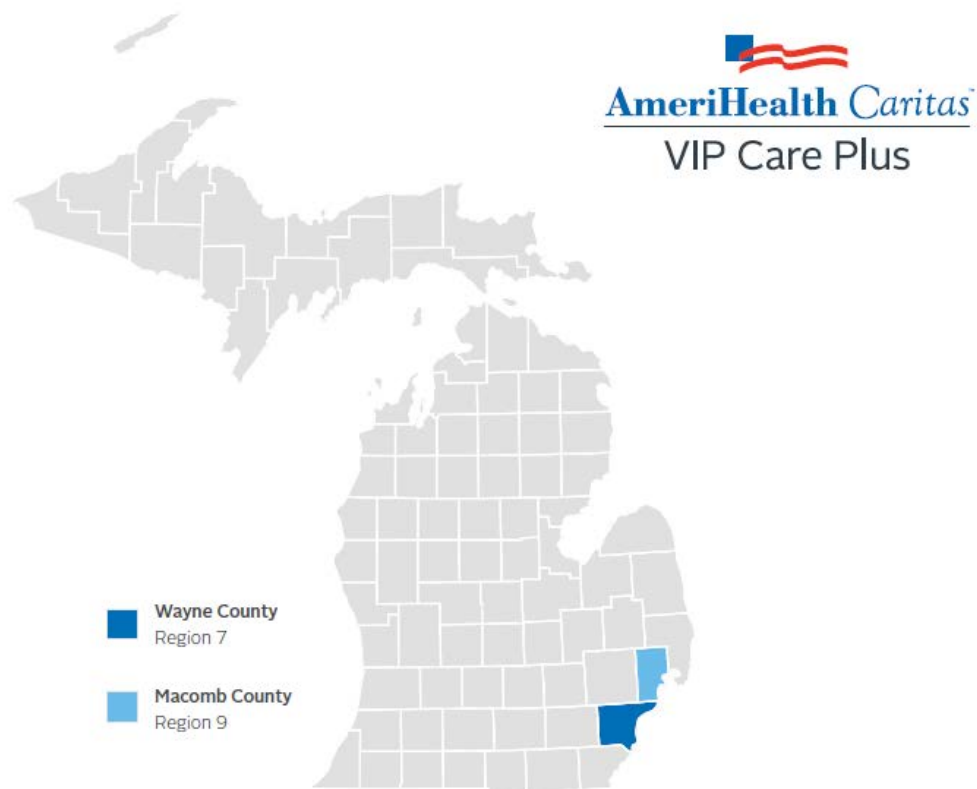
Each enrollee will have a care coordinator who will:

- Work with the AmeriHealth Caritas VIP Care Plus member to create a personal care plan based on the members goals.
- Answer questions and make sure that health care issues get the attention they deserve.
- Connect people to supports and services needed to be healthy and live where they want.

Each participant will have access to an Integrated Care Team that will:

- Include doctors, providers, and anyone else they would like to include.
- Work with them to identify goals and preferences for care and services.

MI Health Link Enrollment Timeline for Wayne and Macomb Counties

Marketing Begins	April 1, 2015
Voluntary Opt In Effective Date	May 1, 2015
Passive Enrollment Member Notification	60 and 30 days prior to enrollment
Passive Enrollment Effective Dates Starting	July 1, 2015



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
